

# Contract Mowing Spec Sheet 2023-2024 Contract



Mowing Contractors,

Please consider the following when submitting your bid for contract mowing with Hardin County Conservation.

- The mowing contract is a two-year contract for mowing seasons April 2023-September 2023 and April 2024-September 2024.
- The properties are broken down into three groups. You must be willing to mow all the areas included in the group, the groups will not be rearranged or broken up.
- You may submit a bid for one group or bids for all three. However, **bidders are only eligible to receive two groups**. If a bidder is lowest on all three, they will be able to choose which two groups they prefer. The remaining group will be offered to the next lowest bid.
- Campgrounds (Bessman-Kemp, Daisy Long, and Pine Ridge) will need to be mowed once a week. All other areas will need to be mowed every 10 days. Weed whacking is required at all areas on a as needed basis. If you cannot perform mowing services by the allotted time, you will forfeit the group and it will be given to another contractor.
- Proof of liability insurance, coverage of 1 million dollars with the Hardin County Conservation Board listed as additionally insured, is required.
- Any herbicide application is to be done by official Hardin County Conservation employees only.

A more detailed discussion of the official contract between the contractor and representative of the Hardin County Conservation Board will take place upon contract review and signing. All bids must be submitted to the Hardin County Conservation Board Headquarters Office at 15537 S Ave. Ackley, IA 50601 in a sealed envelope with Attn: Mowing Bid by 5pm on February 13, 2023.
